Key Points

- The District's 4-Year Graduation rate decreased by approximately 3.2% in 2019-20.
- The drop in graduation rate was most pronounced among African American students within OPS (-4.6%). At the state level, grad rates for African American students also dropped the most compared to other race/ethnicities (-3.5).
- The graduation rate for the 5-Year cohort of 2018-19 students increased to 79.7% with 131 additional students graduating.
- The graduation rate for the 6-Year cohort of 2017-18 students increased to 83.7%, which is average for the past five years.
- The District's 2019-20 dropout rate (3.1%) is back to it's five year high which was also 3.1% in 2016-17.
- The dropout rate has decreased among White students (-0.1%), but has increased most prominently with multi-racial students (+1.5%)

Graduation Rate Formula 4 Year Adjusted Cohort Graduation Rate (ACG)

NDE started using ACG rate during the 2010-11 school year

Numerator: Graduates (4 year only)

Denominator:

- Starts with the original class of True Freshmen
- Adds students who transferred into the district
- Subtracts students who transferred out of the district

of Graduates (4 year only)
True Freshman + Transfers In – Transfers Out

*5 and 6 year graduation rates are also calculated by the Nebraska Department of Education (NDE).

Note: Students who enroll in a program school are counted at their original HS enrollment / School of Assignment



Seeks to answer the question: "of those students who were enrolled at official fall membership, how many dropped out?"

- Numerator: Dropouts (7-12th grade)
- Denominator: Students at Official Fall Membership (7-12th grade)


