

Reynolds she joined him at each of his pastoral assignments, at Lefler United Methodist Church, Omaha; Clair Memorial United Methodist Church, Omaha; LaSalle United Methodist Church, St. Louis, Mo; Centennial United Methodist Church, Kansas City, Mo; Gorham United Methodist Church, Chicago, Il; St. Mark United Methodist Church, Wichita, Ks; Newman United Methodist Church, Lincoln, Ne; St. James Methodist Church, Lincoln, Ne; and various assignments throughout Arkansas and Missouri. Shirley was a "straight A" student throughout grade school and high school.
